## Drip Irrigation for the Home Gardener

When you complete this hands-on workshop you'll know how to graft to create a new tree (scion cutting onto rootstock) or attach add another variety (scion onto existing tree limb). You can make your own tree and take it home. Purchase a rootstock, select a scion, and graft it.
