Water: The wells pumped as follows:

Water levels in the reservoir got low on the hottest days of the month. It took several days to recover. Keeping a close eye on our levels.

Two water service lines were replaced last month. One was leaking pretty well. Seems we always have to do these on the hottest days.

Sewer: The algae blooms in the lagoons are happening a little earlier this year. The odor from this is more than we've had in a long time, still not enough to get complaints from the neighbors.

Streets: Working on weed control in the new storm water detention basins.

Street sweeping is especially tough at this time of the years because there is so little moisture to keep the dust down.

Parks: Getting ready for the Corn Festival. There are all the weeding, table repairs, bees, and all the fixings to get the park in shape. We ordered engineered woodchips for the park play areas. These chips are tumbled to round off the sharp edges of the chips.

A volunteer was working in the park with the weed eater. He stirred up a bees nest and got stung a few times. He left the weed eater at that spot and when they came back to pick it up, it was gone. Still looking into leads to whom may have taken it.

Wildwood Park is a hit with everyone who visits. Still, we have lots to do there to finish up our project.

General: Subdivision inspections still go on. Paving for Flowers PH III is coming up this week and these lots will be ready to go. The Clover Ct subdivision is finishing up their last few items and they should be ready soon.
