

Aumsville Corn Festival 2019

Another year has passed, and it is time to make plans for this year's Corn Festival on August 17th & 18th, 2019.

Below are the Corn Festival registration fees that have been adopted by the Corn Festival Board for all Booth Operators to be aware of. **The registration fee is nonrefundable once you have been accepted into the festival.**

The Fee for non-food booths is \$100.00 with or without electricity. Food booths are \$200.00 with or without electricity and commercial retail is \$500.00 These fees are for a 10' X 10' space. If additional space is needed, additional spaces can be rented at the same rate as stated above. No partial spaces are available.

Please be sure to have all electrical equipment checked out before using it, and please indicate you need it and what voltage and amps required. Portable generators are looked down on, but allowed if they are not too noisy, nor provide excessive smoke when in normal operation and must be indicated on the registration form.

1. All booths are responsible for their coins for change. 2. Booths requiring electricity must bring their own U.L. approved cables to reach the electrical junction box. You must declare your electrical requirements in the application.
3. You may begin setting up on Friday from 7am until 9pm. The day of the festival, all vehicles used in setting up concessions **must** be out of the park by 7:30 A.M. and are **not** to re-enter the Park to pick up the booth until 6:00 P.M. Sunday Aug. 18th. Booth operators are to clean up his or her booth space before leaving the park.
4. Each concession stand shall provide insurance. 5. Each concession shall provide their garbage can; food booths must have at least two garbage cans. Booth operator is responsible for emptying his or her own garbage cans into the dumpster.
6. Food vendors may find it necessary to check with Marion County Health Dept. for license to operate on the 17th & 18th, County Inspectors make their inspections each year to determine if they are licensed or not. Contact the Health Dept at (503) 588-5346 for license information.
7. The Corn Festival Board reserves the right to determine size and number of concessions to provide variety and control duplication.
8. It is imperative that returning vendors return Registration Forms **ASAP**. Spaces are filling up quickly. If you are a new vendor, applying for the first time, the earlier your application and registration fee is received, the better your chance of getting in. Many others may be waiting for a booth space with a similar activity. All vendors will be notified of acceptance by letter on or before June 1. (If your check is cashed, you are in! We will not cash your check until you have been accepted as a vendor) If you find out after you have received the acceptance letter, that you will not be able to be here, please call us and let us know for we have to turn away vendors who would like to have a booth for the Festival.
