Visioning Meeting

Monday, May 23, 2016

CALL TO ORDER: Mayor White called the meeting to order at 7:03 PM in the Aumsville Community Center, 555 Main Street, Aumsville, Oregon. Council present were Councilors Robert Baugh, Nico Casarez, Brian Czarnik, Trina Lee, Della Seney, Lorie Walters, and Mayor White. Administrative Assistant Lora Hofmann was also present.

VISITORS: There was an Eagle Project update from Curtis Clark: he is about ready to install the mini-library at the Community Center and asked about the color of box. Council suggested it compliment the community center, but have a contrasting color. They suggested he ask PW Director Oslie for suggestions. He explained his mission is to reach children who might not be able to get to the Stayton Library and used his sister as an example of someone that didn't have access to a nearby library.


ORDINANCES AND RESOLUTIONS: AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 323, THE DEVELOPMENT ORDINANCE AND TO UPDATE THE AUMSVILLE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN MAPS IN ORDINANCE NO. 465. Councilor Casarez made a motion to adopt the Ordinance. Voting in favor of the motion were Councilors Baugh, Casarez, Czarnik, Lee, Seney, Walters, and Mayor White. The motion passed unanimously.

CONTRACT REVIEW BOARD: There was one bid received for the recent request for New Tower Water Supply Well Work and it was high. City Engineer Schuette recommends that the bid is rejected. Councilor Baugh made a motion to reject the bid of Westerberg Drilling Company of Molalla and re-bid the job. Voting in favor of the motion were Councilors Baugh, Casarez, Czarnik, Lee, Seney, Walters, and Mayor White. The motion passed unanimously.


UNFINISHED BUSINESS:
