

ORDINANCE NO. 530

**AN ORDINANCE PRESCRIBING CITY COUNCIL ELECTION NOMINATIONS.**

WHEREAS, the Aumsville Charter of 2003 states that a person may be nominated by petition or by filing fee, as prescribed by general ordinance, to run for an elective office of the city; now therefore,

The City of Aumsville ordains as follows:

SECTION 1. QUALIFICATIONS. A qualified voter residing within the City of Aumsville during the 12 months immediately preceding assumption of office may be nominated for the office of mayor or city councilor.

SECTION 2. NOMINATION BY PETITION. A candidacy nomination may be made by petition containing the signatures of not less than 25 qualified voters in the city, for nomination to the office of mayor or city councilor.

SECTION 3. NOMINATION BY FILING FEE. Filing of candidacy may also be made by declaration, with a \$25.00 filing fee, for nomination to the office of mayor or city councilor.

SECTION 4. EFFECTIVE DATE. This ordinance shall take effect on the thirtieth day after its enactment.

PRESENTED AND PASSED the first reading on the 9th day of February, 2004. PASSED its second reading on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2004. ADOPTED by the Aumsville City Council on the 23<sup>rd</sup> day of February, 2004.
